Today's event has replaced The Dunes event originally scheduled for Tuesday May 11, as Sandhurst provided a more cost effective framework including carts for our members.

Golf course architects Thomson and Perrett designed the Champions Course in dedication to past champions of the Professional Golfers' Association of Australia. Holes on the sandbelt styled course feature a plaque near each tee as a tribute to the relevant skills and attributes of the past champion, after whom each hole has been dedicated. The Sandhurst Club is home to two of Victoria's great golf courses, rated in Australia's top 100 courses, and home of the Australian PGA.

The morning conditions were cool with showers forecast but we were fortunate to complete the round with only very light rain drops. The golf course was in very good condition. Golf balls were presented to 30 players who had 32 points or more.

We extended a warm welcome to all our member guests Matthew Borchin from Sandhurst and Dorothy Nikolaidis from Normandy Park.
