POLICIES

1 – Heat and Hazardous Weather.

The President or Captain or Secretary are to inform Members when forecast hot weather (36c or above) coincides with one of our game days. It is then up to the individuals to decide if they play or not.

If the weather is considered Hazardous to play, anyone of the President, Captain or Secretary will where possible inform the Members as soon as practical the event has been cancelled or delayed.

While the Association follows Golf Australia's Hot Weather Guidelines (members are encouraged to read – available on Rules, Bylaws and Policy Page), the Association also needs to abide by the rulings of the Host Club on the day to take account of local conditions.

2 – Privacy

Personal information will be used in accordance with the Privacy Act. It will not be used for any other purpose other than for which it was collected. We may use your personal information if:

- it is authorised or required by law or
- You have consented to the use or
- The use meets one of the other exceptions in the Australian Privacy Principles.

No personal information will be passed onto any other organisation

3 – Definition of “Home Club”

The Home Club is the Club where a Member is a Financial Playing Member of that Club.

4 – Definition of “Host Club”

The Host Club is the Club where the golf event is being played.

5 – Definition of “Local Member”

A “Local Member” is a financial playing member of the Host Club – this definition does not extend to cover any reciprocal arrangements held by members of other Golf Clubs in respect to the Host Club.
