Captain's Report for 2013

The 2013 calendar year was my first year as Captain of the MDVGA. It is a great honour and very enjoyable to represent MDVGA in this capacity.

Twenty games were played during this period, with Sandhurst being played for the first time. Unfortunately we had one disappointing course, that being Kew at the end of 2012. The condition of the course at the time was poor and not up to the standard we normally expect.

We recently played the Club Championship and Handicap Bowl over two rounds at Commonwealth and Woodlands. Congratulations to our winners, Gary Cornish and Bob Tschudin, both from Box Hill for their consistent efforts over the two rounds.

In 2014 there will be a change to the format for the Club Championship. The first stroke round will be played in conjunction with the Cranbourne Cup. The best eight scores, including ties from Cranbourne, will then proceed to the second round at Long Island.

Please note to be eligible to play in the Club Championship you will be required to play four MDVGA golf games during the 2013 calendar year.

The Handicap Bowl will continue to be played over two rounds at Commonwealth and Woodlands.

Golfer of the year for 2012 was won by Wes Taylor, very well done in playing consistently good golf during the year.

As you know match reports are sent out immediately after each game. These are emailed to our Liaison Officers to pass on to their MDVGA members.

2014 programme of events will have two changes –

- * Green Acres replacing Kew.
- The exciting new course to our programme will be Royal Melbourne replacing Patterson River.

It was decided by the committee we should have one special event during the year at a tier one golf course. The cost of this game will be \$110, which is a reasonable fee for the enjoyment of playing golf at the top course in Australia. We also negotiated effectively to have us play the west course.

As you know we celebrated our 30th Anniversary at Spring Valley in August with golf and a special sit down luncheon after our game. A special thank you to our members who supported this important day. Good prizes were provided with the help of our major sponsor LTD Promotional Ware P/L. Also thank you to Merv Tappenden who kindly provided a generous cash donation for our 30th. Anniversary.

During the year we also played our usual two District Matches with Dalhousie at Kilmore and Hume at Gisborne. These are great days to attend, especially with the warm and friendly welcome we receive. On both occasions the MDVGA were successful in defending the trophies.

I am pleased to report that the pre booking on line at www.mdvetgolf.org continues to work very effectively. Special thank you to Kevin Milner for his continued effort and support for this important part of our golfing administration programme.

In conclusion, thank you to our entire hard working committee who are dedicated to continue to be professional in their approach in providing an excellent platform for enjoyable games of golf.

TREASURERS REPORT 2013

I report that the District operated with a small deficit of \$838.47 against the budgeted shortfall of \$464 – This shortfall was largely a result of lower than expected recruitment of new members 48 against the usual 60 or so and the VVGA affiliation fee increase from \$3 to \$4 which resulted in an additional expense of \$441. As you can see from the Receipts/Expenses statement, there were some ups & downs, specifically I would like to highlight the fact that the amount expended on Trophies/Balls & the Affiliation Fee amounted to \$8,956 which is 71% of your annual subscriptions and with these factors in mind the years results are considered acceptable.

I would like to thank Stewart Ley our Secretary for the time and effort put into the District, also thanks to Kevin Milner as our Webmaster – his expertise in computers is of great advantage to our Membership and his overseeing of the ongoing enhancements on our website is very much appreciated. My thanks also to the members of the Operations Team who look after the cash on game days.

I would also like to add my personal appreciation for the efforts of all the other Members of your Committee and would like to take the opportunity to thank the retiring members Paul Campbell, Keith Kendall & Richard Froebel for their contributions to Committee and welcome the incoming members Frank Martel, Ian Tait & Larry Wilson. Also thanks to Bill Rhoden who is stepping down from his role as Membership Secretary.

I have pleasure in presenting these accounts to the Membership and would propose that the Audited accounts as presented be approved and in accordance with our Constitution that the continuance of our current annual fees of \$30 (with a rebate of \$5 to those Members who have attained the age of 70 and have completed five years of membership) and also the continuance of the nomination fee of \$70 be approved.


