CAPTAIN'S REPORT for 2016

Following several years on committee, it has been an honor and pleasure to serve my first year as Captain. Thank you to past Captain Max Vine for his support and advice in the handover to my new role.

The 2015/16 season so far has been successful and enjoyable, and well attended by members and guests with an increase in individual games played over last season of 3%. In fact over 2000 rounds of golf have been played representing fee payments to clubs of some \$124,000. Based on these figures, our Melbourne district association represents a very important contribution to Victorian golf and the clubs we visit.

The number of games in the 2016 schedule has been reduced to nineteen from the previous year of twenty resulting in playing each course once and reducing the frequency of games played during the cold winter months. In addition the new courses introduced this year in Eastern, The Dunes and Yarra Yarra has proved popular with members.

This year two new initiatives were introduced. An additional nearest the pin prize is offered at the shortest Par 3 hole. This is known as the "Money Hole" and closest to the pin at that hole will receive \$50 cash on the day. This prize has been introduced to provide additional interest for all members on event days.

Also a random draw of current members was conducted at Cranbourne GC on the 15th February and five members received a voucher for one free game of golf each from the MDVGA 2016 fixture. The lucky winners were Colin Stott (Sandhurst), Paul Sidebottom (Northern), Bob Fraser (Southern), Paul Julian (Eastern) and Bruce Farmer (Kew)

This year a new and improved web site has been introduced that provides easier access to various sections of the website, including the usual on line booking features, expanded information, news and match reports. Thanks go to Committeeman Ian Tait for his foresight and development of the new and updated website. I am also pleased to report and acknowledge the work put in by our Webmaster Kevin Milner in the continued refinement of our on line booking and match day score processing and presentation system.

In conclusion, thank you to all members of committee who have assisted me in the match duties to ensure that our games of golf run smoothly for the enjoyment of our members.




