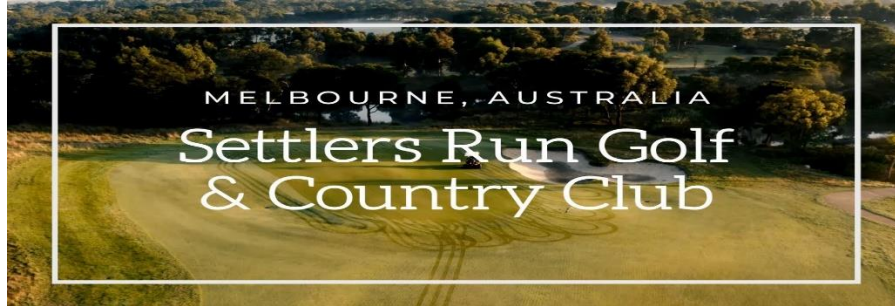




Settlers Run – 28 March 2022

Our next event is at the Dunes. Below is an extract from the Dunes website with respect to the Dress Regulations for the Dunes:

Dress regulations

The Dunes requests neat golf attire on course at all times. The following is the dress standard that is required while on the course:

- Collared shirts are compulsory
- Slacks or shorts must be tailored. Predominately white socks are to be worn when wearing shorts. No football socks will be allowed
- No Denim attire is accepted.
- Football Jerseys, T-shirts or Track Suits are non-complying with the dress standards
- Golf shoes are the preferred footwear, shoes that are not golf shoes must enclose the feet and have flat soles
- The Dunes Golf Links is a compulsory soft spike course.
