Many members at Spring Valley and previously at Yarra Yarra were given an initial password for their OneGolf accounts. I would ask those members to change that password to something that they will remember.

The actual bookings for Cranbourne will be via the existing booking system however OneGolf booking for Cranbourne will be open at the same time as a trial, so I would encourage members who book into the Cranbourne event using the existing booking system to also log on to OneGolf and book themselves into the same tee position as they have on the current booking system so that you can get yourself familiar with the system. This will minimise issues when the actual booking system changeover takes place. If a member has trouble with the trial Cranbourne OneGolf booking one of the committee will be able to take you through it after the presentations at Cranbourne.

On the OneGolf fixtures list there is also a test event with the date 25 Dec 2023 at St. Andrews – The Old Course. Feel free to use this event to add a booking, delete a booking etc. to get yourself familiar with OneGolf booking. With respect to adding a guest all you need is a valid Golflink number, not a name. OneGolf will automatically check if the entered Golflink number is a valid number and the name associated with that Golflink number will be displayed on the booking sheet so you will be able to see if you have the correct Golflink number or not.
