

MELBOURNE DISTRICT VETERAN GOLFERS ASSOCIATION CRANBOURNE CUP

The Cranbourne Cup was up until 2023 a single round Stroke event played at the Cranbourne Golf Club and was played concurrently with the 1st round of the club championship. The event was not played in 2024 or 2025. In 2026 the Cranbourne Golf Club donated the actual Cup, originally owned by the club, to the MDVGA.

In 2026 the Cranbourne Cup event has been returned to the MDVGA schedule of events. The event's name will be retained as the "Cranbourne Cup" and will be played each year at the club hosting the 1st round of the club championships as a single round gross stroke event.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entrants must be a **financial member of the MDVGA** and have a current handicap.
2. There is **no additional cost** to play, just the normal entry fees for the daily event.
3. The overall stroke winner is not eligible to receive a daily grade prize.

COMPETITION FORMAT

1. This is a **gross stroke competition** played over one (1) round of 18 holes.
2. The player with the best gross stroke score will be declared the winner.
3. In the event of a tie occurring, the winner will be decided by count-back with the Golf Australia approved system being used.
4. If for any reason the round is cancelled before all competitors have completed their round, the **MDVGA Match Committee** may decide to cancel the round and reschedule to another day.
5. Any disputes will be decided by the **MDVGA Match Committee** whose decision will be final.
